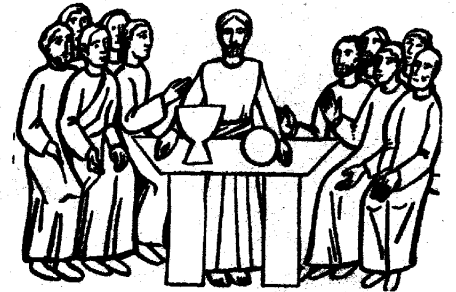


HOLY WEEK

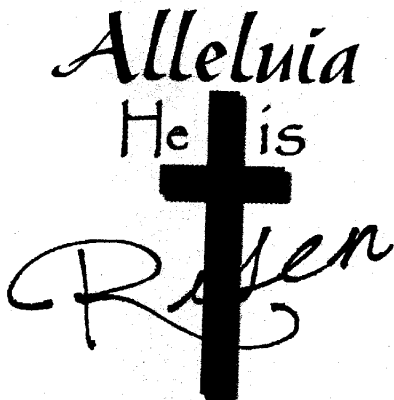
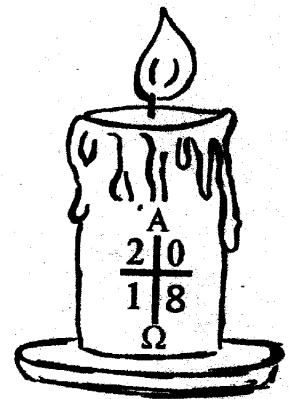


GOOD FRIDAY - March 30th - 12:15 P.M.

Good Friday is a celebration of the passion, the suffering and death by crucifixion of Jesus. Because this event won salvation for sinners, the day is called "Good" and the liturgy reflects on love as much as loss. For the faithful, today's commemoration drives home the full weight of our sin, even as it lifts us up by the incomparable measure of God's love. For the elect, today's dramatic reflection awakens them to the demands of discipleship while it prepares them to receive God's love in the promise of eternal life by the waters of baptism. The collection on Good Friday is for the Holy Land. all are asked to leave the Church in **SILENCE**.

HOLY SATURDAY - March 31st - 7:30 P.M.

On Holy Saturday we commemorate the day Jesus lay in the tomb. During the day today we continue the paschal fast. We continue a prayerful spirit. The climax of the Triduum, the Easter Vigil begins when darkness arrives. The Easter Vigil launches us into the Easter season and should not be confused with Holy Saturday itself. A reception to welcome our newest members will follow in the Parish Hall.
